Variation Request – Centre [REDACTED]

1. Members are asked to consider the variation request to vary the centre's treatment licence to amend the standard condition regarding the patient selection criteria for PGS.

2. The centre wishes to vary the licence to amend the standard condition 6 (e) as follows:

- a) that PGS for aneuploidy may only be used in the treatment of the following categories of patient:
 - (i) women over 35 years of age
 - (ii) women with a history of recurrent miscarriage not caused by translocations or other chromosomal rearrangements
 - (iii) women with several previous failed IVF attempts where embryos have been transferred,

to include patients with male factor infertility

Recommendation

3. The executive requests that the Members consider whether they agree to the variation of the condition to include male factor infertility, or whether it wishes to inform the centre that this is an issue that the whole Authority should revisit before any such licensing decision is to be made.
