**Keeping gametes and embryos in the course of carriage between premises.**

1. These Directions revoke D.1991/3.
2. These Directions authorise the keeping, by or on behalf of a person to whom a licence applies, of gametes and embryos in the course of their carriage to or from any premises, as specified below.
3. In relation to gametes or embryos that are not intended for human application, these Directions authorise the keeping, by or on behalf of a person to whom a licence applies, of gametes or embryos in the course of their carriage to or from any premises.
4. In relation to gametes or embryos that are intended for human application, these Directions authorise the keeping of gametes or embryos by or on behalf of a person to whom a licence applies, in the course of their carriage –
  - a) between premises to which licences relate,
  - b) between such premises and relevant third party premises,
  - c) between premises referred to in paragraphs (a) and (b) above and tissue establishments accredited, designated, authorised, or licensed under the laws, or other measures, of Gibraltar or of an EEA state other than the United Kingdom which implement the first, second or third Directive, or

- d) between premises referred to in paragraphs (a) and (b) and tissue establishments in a country which is not an EEA state, pursuant to any Directions made under section 24 (4) of the Act.
