THE HUMAN FERTILISATION AND EMBRYOLOGY ACT 1990**

Keeping gametes and embryos in the course of carriage between premises

These Directions are:	GENERAL DIRECTIONS
Section of Act providing for these Directions:	Section 24(3)
These Directions come into force on:	1 August 1991
These Directions remain in force:	Until revoked.

1. Any person to whom a licence applies, and any other person on behalf of a person to whom a licence applies, may keep gametes or embryos while they are being transported between licensed premises if the terms of these Directions are complied with.
2. Gametes or embryos may be kept while they are being transported between licensed premises only if any information relating to the gametes or embryos in question which has been specified in directions under section 12(f) of the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Act 1990 is also supplied.

[NOTE: Section 12(f) says that it is a condition of every licence that, where gametes or embryos are supplied to a person to whom another licence applies, that person is also to be provided with such information as the Authority may specify in directions.]
