1. Under a research licence centres must keep the following information in any appropriate form: the results of the research project and the conclusions drawn from them.
2. Centres must make a provisional report to the HFEA of the results and conclusions of the research project within three months of its end. A final report of results, conclusions and references to any publications arising from the research project must be made to the HFEA as soon as reasonably practicable.
3. Centres holding records in computer form must also be able to produce hard copies of record.

SCHEDULE

Modifications of sections 12 to 14 of the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Act 1990 in relation to exported in accordance with these Directions

Section 12 has effect in relation to gametes exported in accordance with these Directions as if at the end there were added:

" (h) that directions given by virtue of paragraph (f) above shall apply in relation to gametes sent outside the United Kingdom in accordance with directions given by virtue of section 24(4) of this Act as they apply in relation to gametes supplied to a person to whom another licence applies,

(i) that a record shall be kept of any such gametes sent outside the United Kingdom, together with the date on which they were sent, the person to whom they were sent and the purpose for which they were sent, and

(j) that the information recorded in pursuance of paragraph (i) above shall be given to the Authority within two working days of the gametes' being sent outside the United Kingdom."

Section 14(1)(b) has effect in relation to gametes exported in accordance with these Directions as if at the end there were added "or, in relation to gametes sent outside the United Kingdom in accordance with directions given by virtue of section 24(3) of this Act. a person outside the United Kingdom".
