1. These Directions are made for the purposes of ensuring that all Licensed Centres record and provide to the Authority the information referred to in Regulation 2 of The Human Fertilisation and Embryology Authority (Disclosure of Donor Information) Regulations 2004 (“the Regulations”).
2. With effect from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2004 Licensed Centres must use Donor Information form (Form D v. 2004) (a copy of which is attached to these Directions) for the recording of information relating to donors. This form replaces form HFEA Register (99) D.I.O.
3. Sections 1 to 20 must be completed for each donor by the Licensed Centre.
4. Licensed Centres must ensure that donors complete fields 21,22,23,24 and 25 (to cover information required by paragraph 2(2)(f) of the Regulations to be disclosed from the HFEA Register to applicants under s.31 of the Human Fertilisation & Embryology Act 1990).
5. Licensed Centres must also ensure that the attention of donors is drawn to the pen portrait and goodwill message in fields 26 and 27 and to the importance that this may have for a donor-conceived person.
6. Save as provided above, Directions D1999/1 (Directions on Records) remain in force and continue to apply to all other forms covered by those Directions. The requirements contained in Sections A and B of Directions D1999/1 shall be deemed to apply to Form D v. 2004 as introduced by these Directions.
