

out preimplantation testing**

These Directions are	GENERAL DIRECTIONS

These Directions taken effect on :	15 August 2005
These Directions remain in force:	Until revoked

1. An application for a licence to carry out Preimplantation Genetic Diagnosis (PGD) and / or Preimplantation Genetic Screening for aneuploidies (PGS) **for the first time** must be made by completing and submitting the application form set out in Schedule 1 to these Directions.
2. A centre licensed to carry out PGD wishing to test for genetic conditions which are not expressly authorised by the centre's licence, must complete and submit the application form as set out in Schedule 2 to these Directions.
3. A centre applying to be licensed to carry out HLA tissue typing in isolation or in conjunction with PGD must complete and submit the application form as set out in Schedule 3 to these Directions.
