Any withdrawal of consent by a person who has previously given a consent required under Schedule 3 to the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Act 1990, as amended, or under sections 37(1) or 44(1) of Part 2 of the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Act 2008, must be recorded in the WC form which is set out in the Schedule to these Directions.
