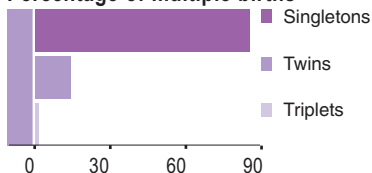

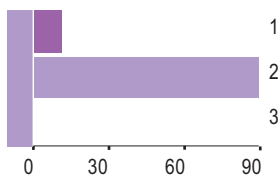

Percentage of ICSI (40%) vs IVF (60%) for the Centre

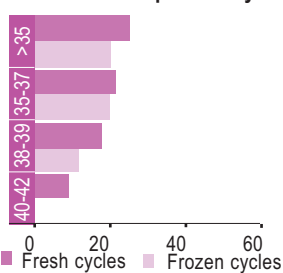
Percentage of multiple births

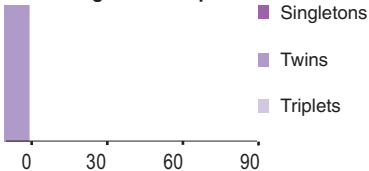

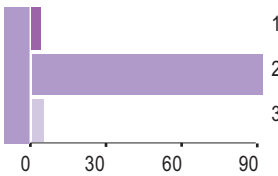

Percentage of ICSI (38%) vs IVF (62%) for the Centre

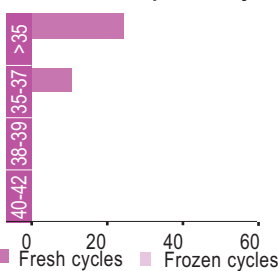
Percentage of multiple births

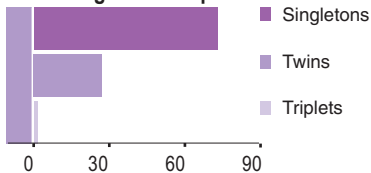

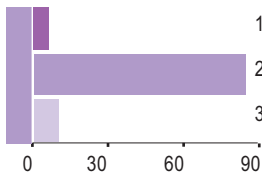

Percentage of ICSI (36%) vs IVF (64%) for the Centre

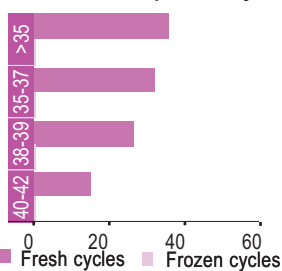
Percentage of multiple births

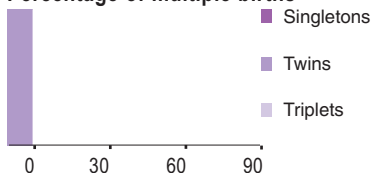

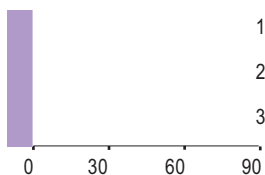

Percentage of ICSI (0%) vs IVF (0%) for the Centre

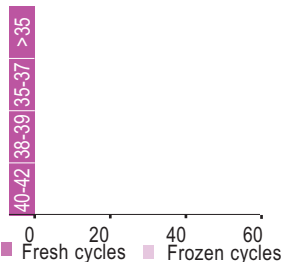
Percentage of multiple births

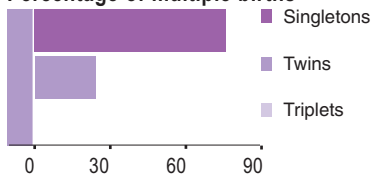

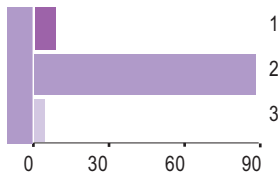

Percentage of ICSI (42%) vs IVF (58%) for the Centre

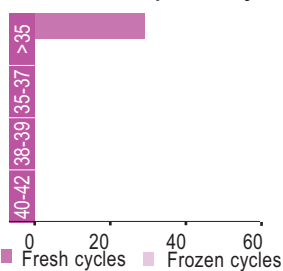
Percentage of multiple births

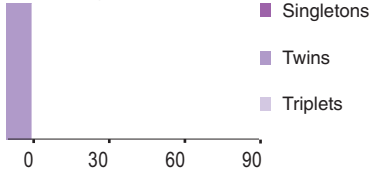

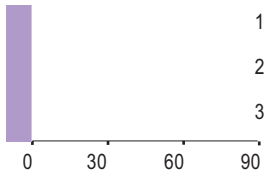

Percentage of ICSI (0%) vs IVF (0%) for the Centre

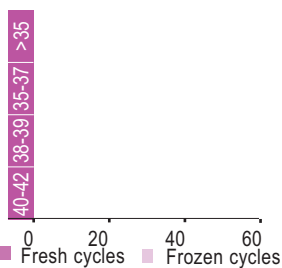
Percentage of multiple births
