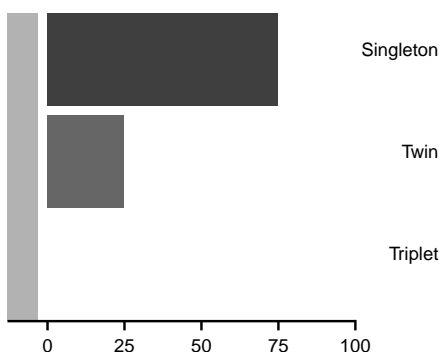

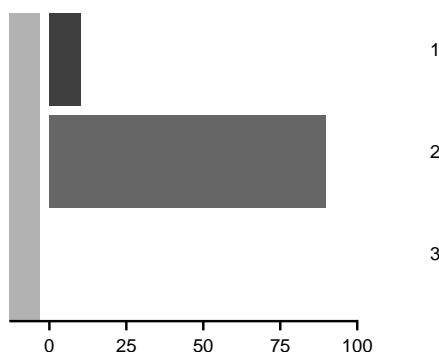

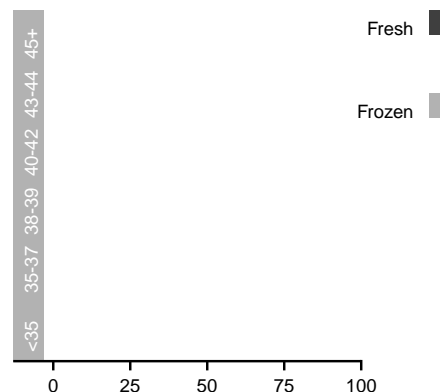
Percentage of multiple births

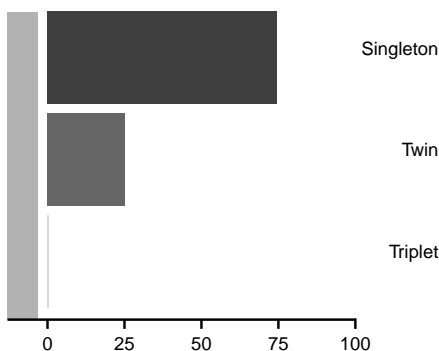

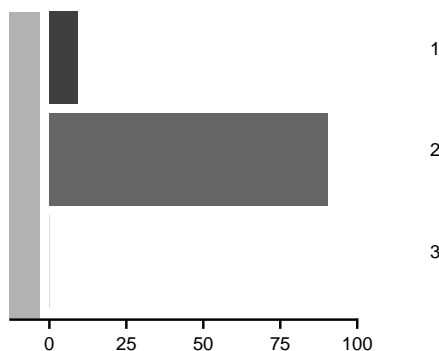

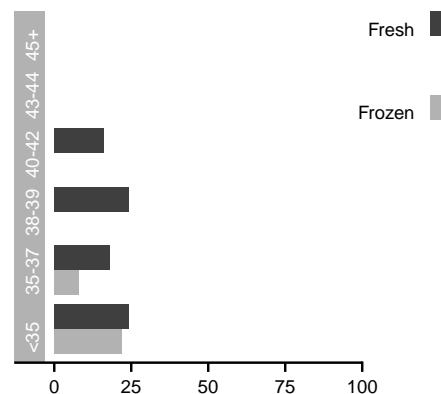
## Percentage of multiple births
