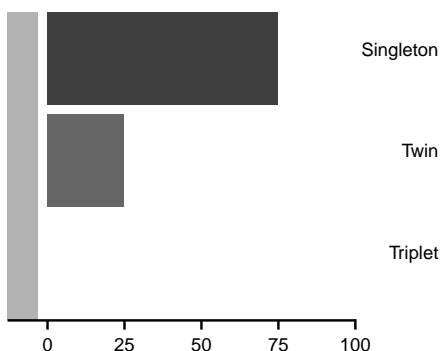

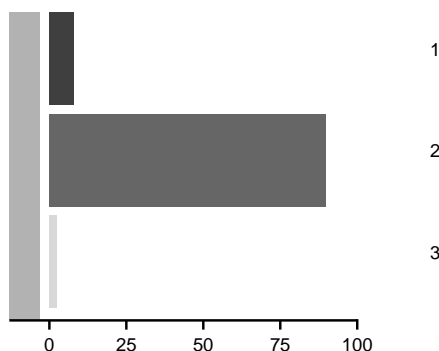

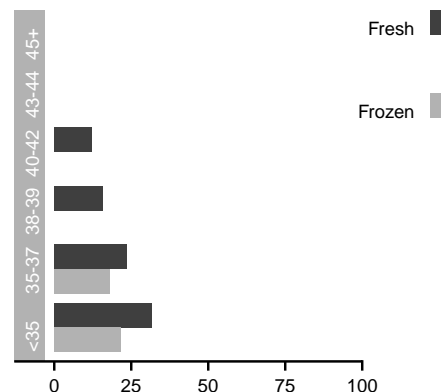
Percentage of multiple births

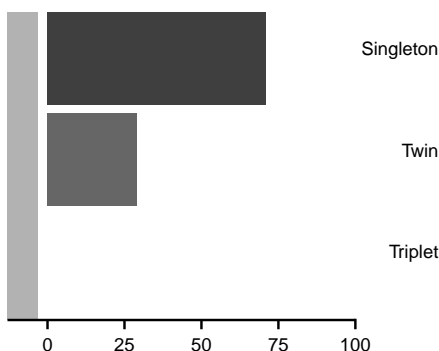

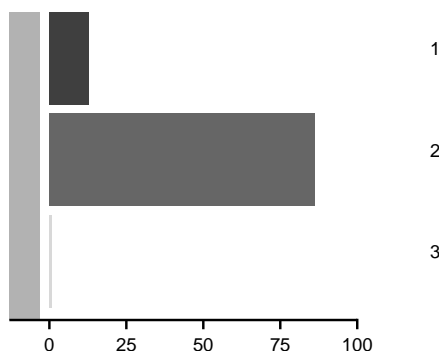

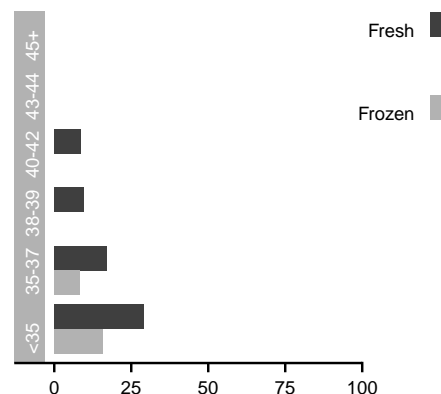
Percentage of multiple births

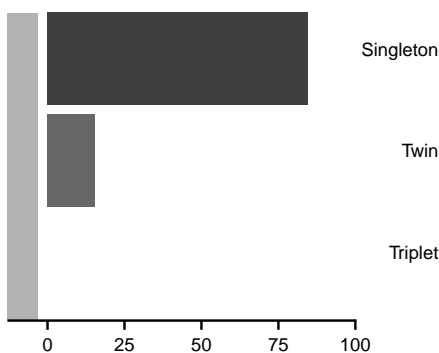

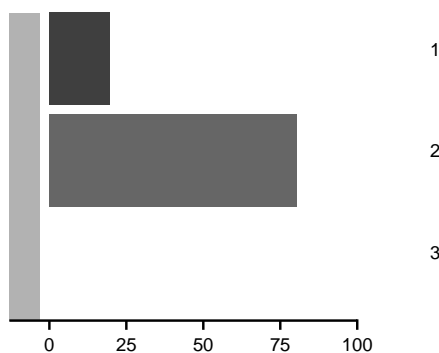

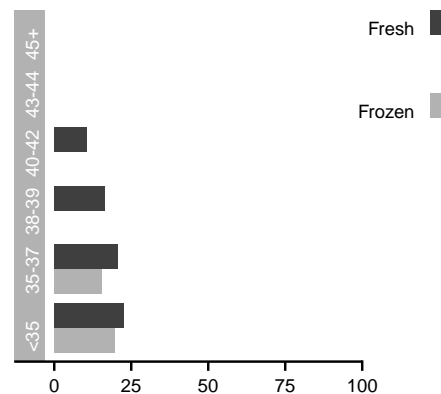
Percentage of multiple births

The statistics for this centre are under review. The data for this centre has been withheld from publication. To ensure the accuracy of data published by the HFEA, every attempt has been made to verify the information previously received from this centre but at this point we are not confident in the data. The verification exercise carried out with centres ensures that the data held for their activities in the period is both comprehensive and accurate. Crucially, it improves the HFEAs ability to answer Opening the Register requests from donor conceived offspring & their parents or from interested donors by filling potential gaps in the data sent by centres. The HFEA does not take the decision to withhold data lightly and this fact should be taken into account by patients. The review process is explained in Chief Executive's letter CE(06)08.
