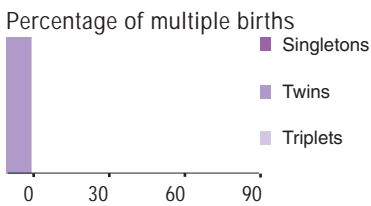

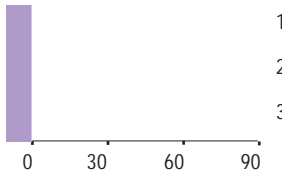

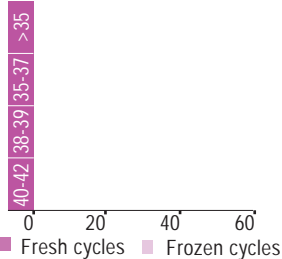
Percentage of ICSI (0%) vs IVF (0%) for the Centre

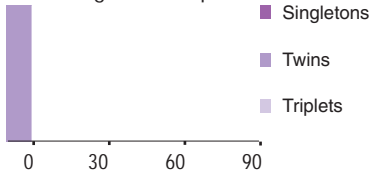

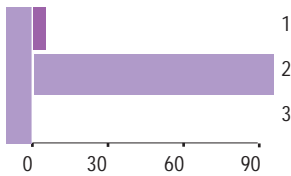

Percentage of ICSI (31%) vs IVF (69%) for the Centre

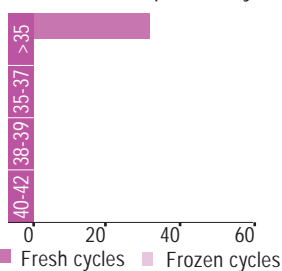
Percentage of multiple births

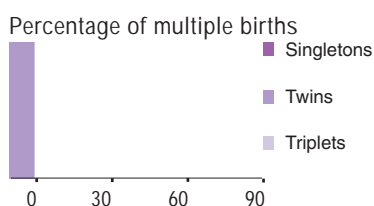

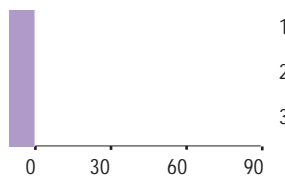

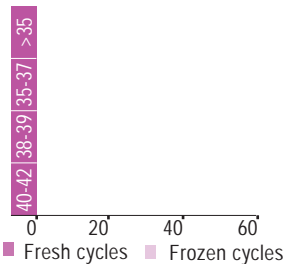
Percentage of ICSI (0%) vs IVF (0%) for the Centre

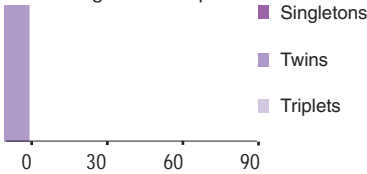

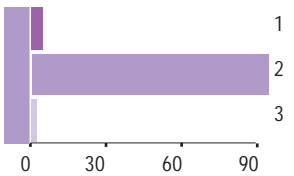

Percentage of ICSI (50%) vs IVF (50%) for the Centre

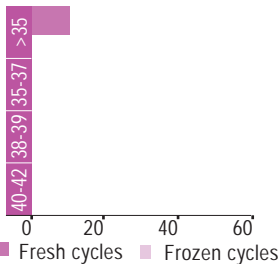
Percentage of multiple births

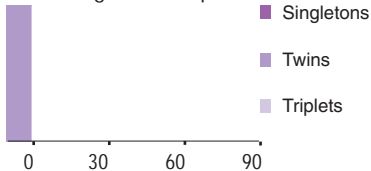

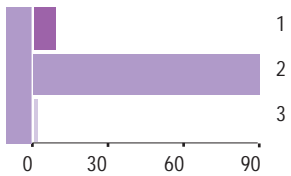

Percentage of ICSI (49%) vs IVF (51%) for the Centre

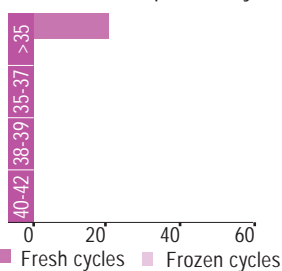
Percentage of multiple births

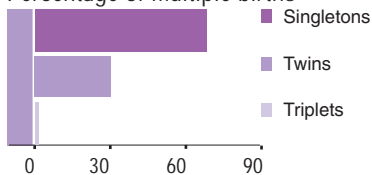

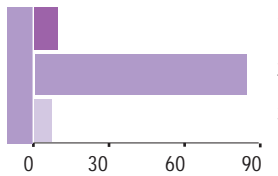

Percentage of ICSI (59%) vs IVF (41%) for the Centre

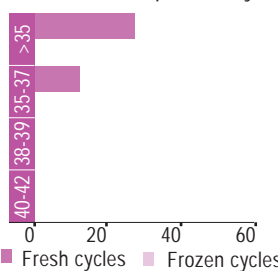
Percentage of multiple births

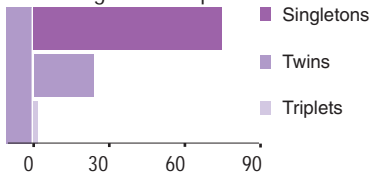

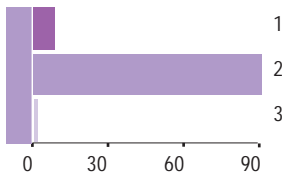

Percentage of ICSI (43%) vs IVF (57%) for the Centre

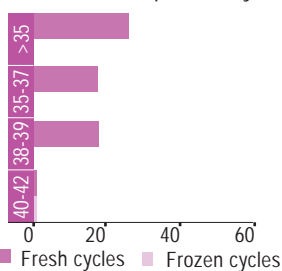
Percentage of multiple births
