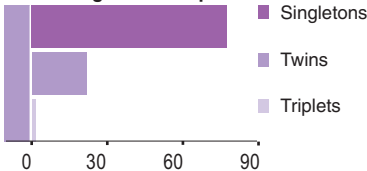

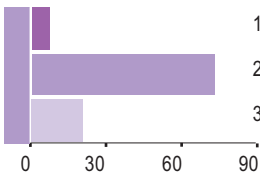

Percentage of ICSI (41%) vs IVF (59%) for the Centre

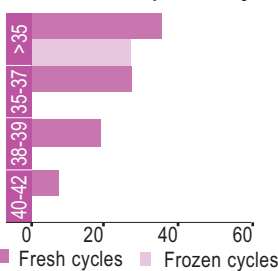
### Percentage of multiple births

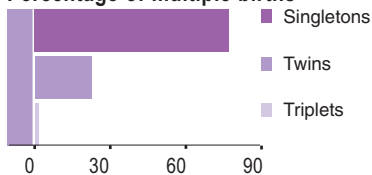

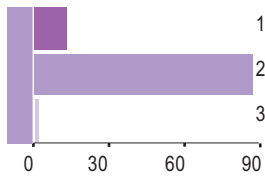

Percentage of ICSI (51%) vs IVF (49%) for the Centre

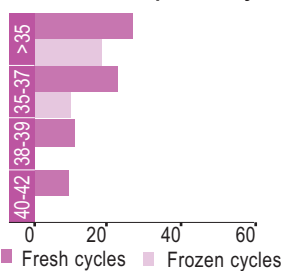
Percentage of multiple births

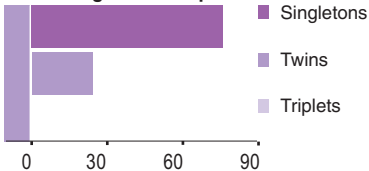

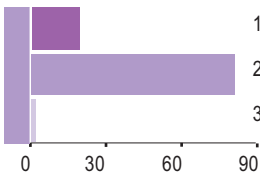

Percentage of ICSI (44%) vs IVF (56%) for the Centre

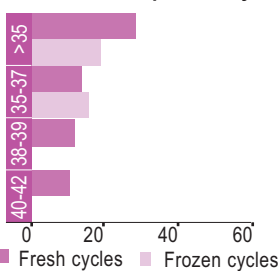
### Percentage of multiple births

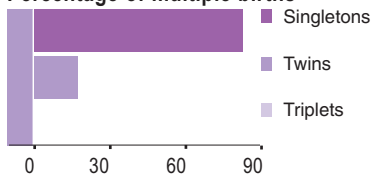

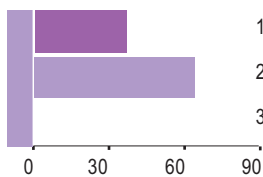

Percentage of ICSI (31%) vs IVF (69%) for the Centre

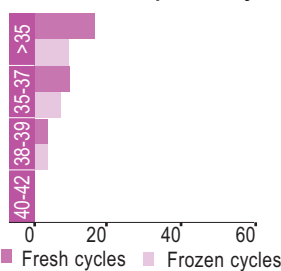
Percentage of multiple births
