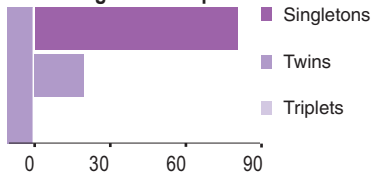

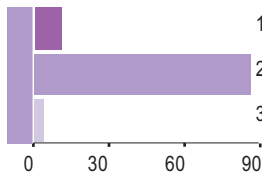

IVF (61%) for the Centre

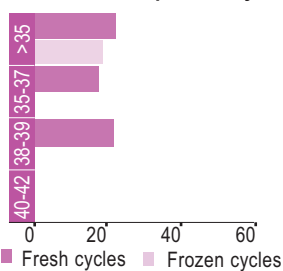
Percentage of multiple births

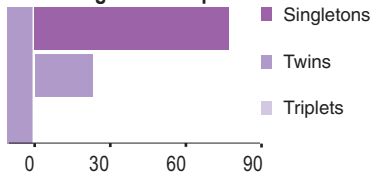

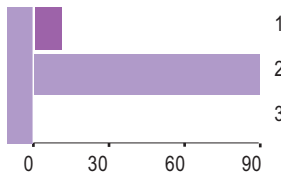

Percentage of ICSI (31%) vs IVF (69%) for the Centre

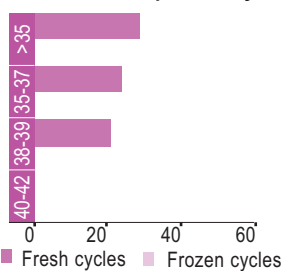
Percentage of multiple births

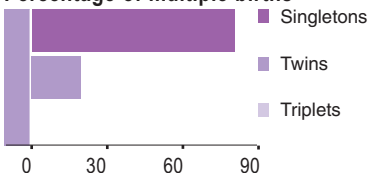

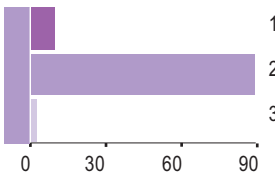

Percentage of ICSI (43%) vs IVF (57%) for the Centre

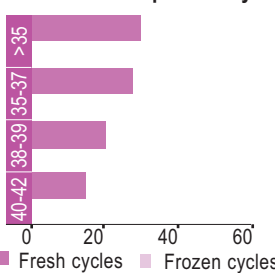
Percentage of multiple births

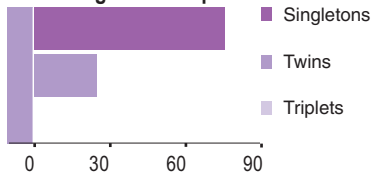

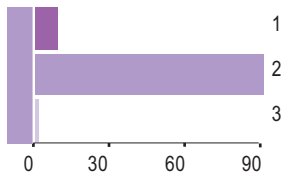

Percentage of ICSI (43%) vs IVF (57%) for the Centre

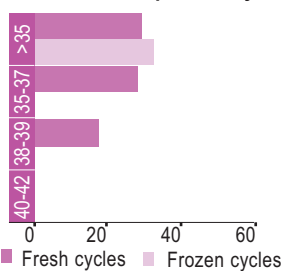
Percentage of multiple births

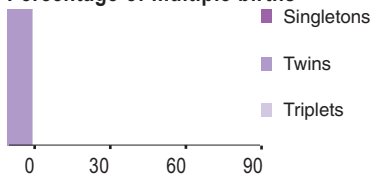

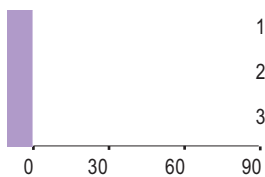

Percentage of ICSI (40%) vs IVF (60%) for the Centre

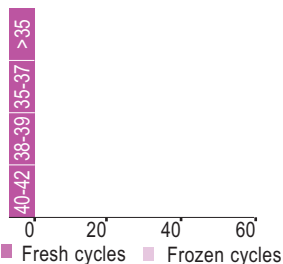
Percentage of multiple births

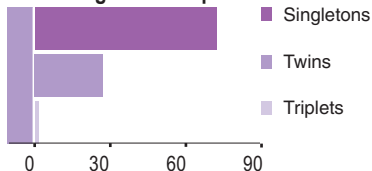

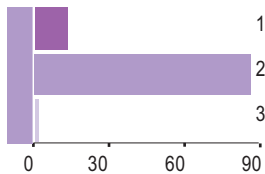

Percentage of ICSI (40%) vs IVF (60%) for the Centre

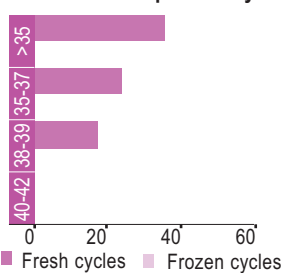
Percentage of multiple births
