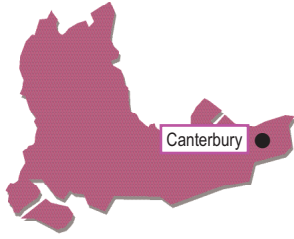

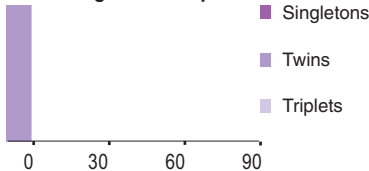

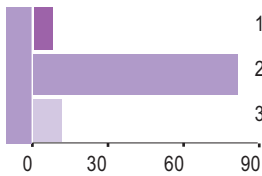

Percentage of ICSI (39%) vs IVF (61%) for the Centre

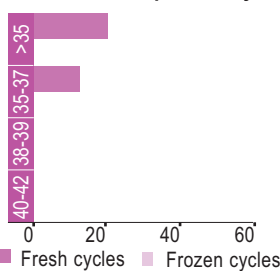
Percentage of multiple births

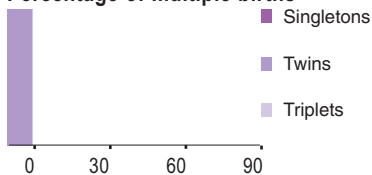

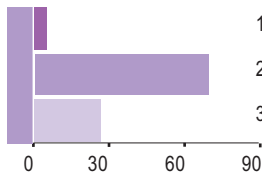

Percentage of ICSI (33%) vs IVF (67%) for the Centre

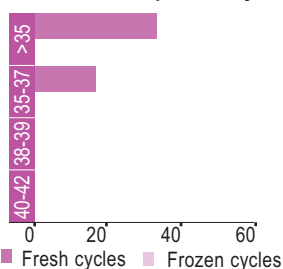
Percentage of multiple births

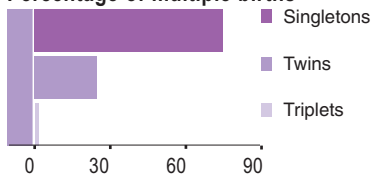

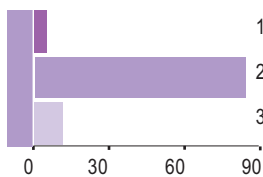

Percentage of ICSI (43%) vs IVF (57%) for the Centre

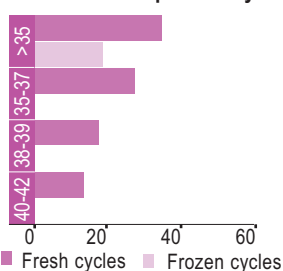
Percentage of multiple births

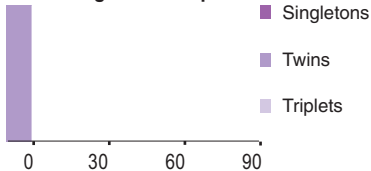

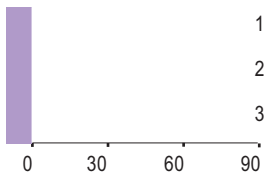

Percentage of ICSI (0%) vs IVF (0%) for the Centre

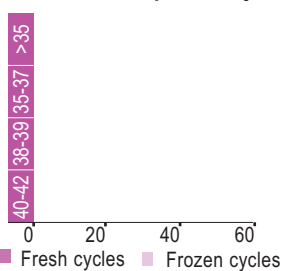
Percentage of multiple births

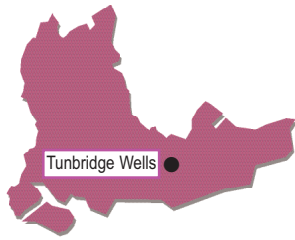

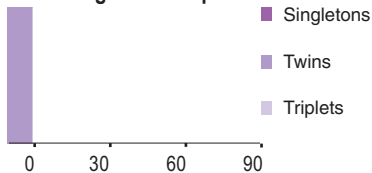

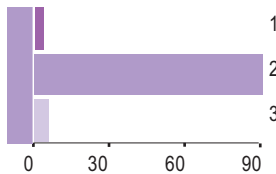

IVF (75%) for the Centre

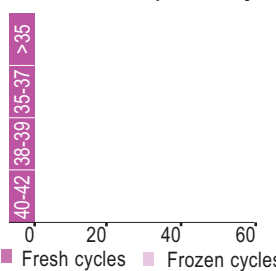
Percentage of multiple births

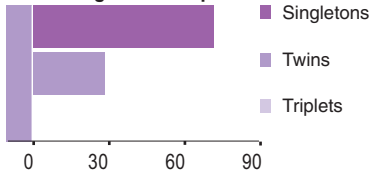

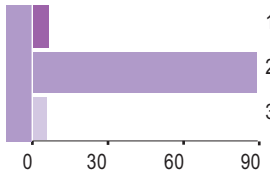

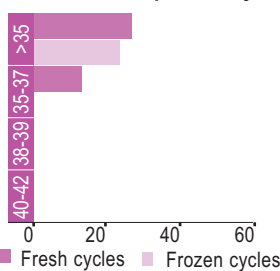
Percentage of multiple births

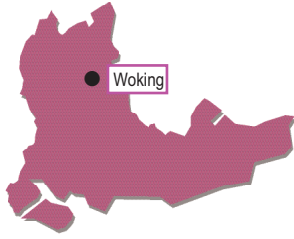

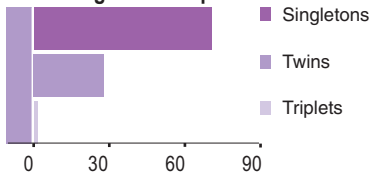

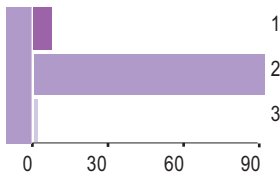

Percentage of ICSI (29%) vs IVF (71%) for the Centre

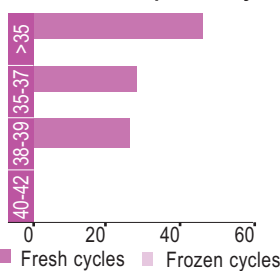
Percentage of multiple births

IVF Activities
