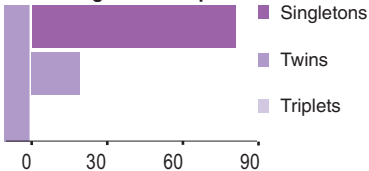

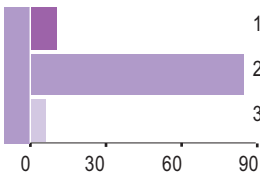

Percentage of ICSI (49%) vs IVF (51%) for the Centre

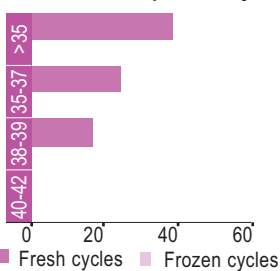
### Percentage of multiple births

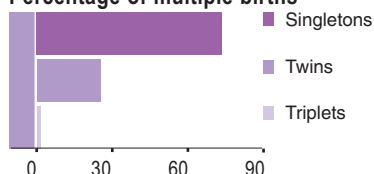

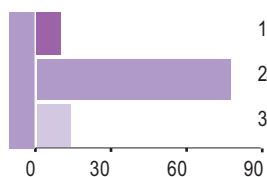

Percentage of ICSI (52%) vs IVF (48%) for the Centre

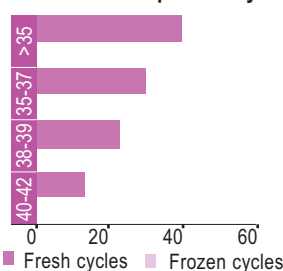
Percentage of multiple births

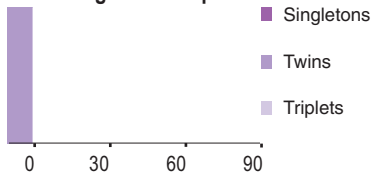

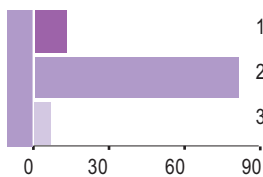

Percentage of ICSI (44%) vs IVF (56%) for the Centre

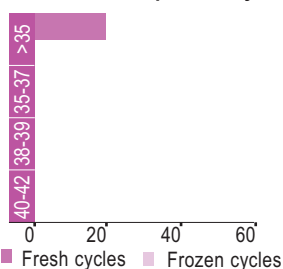
Percentage of multiple births

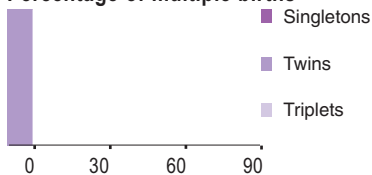

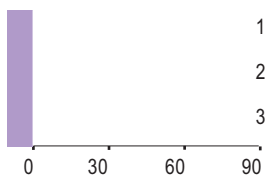

IVF (64%) for the Centre

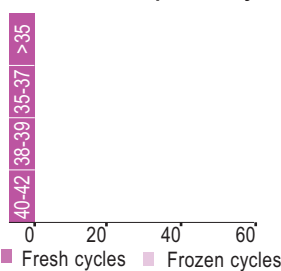
Percentage of multiple births

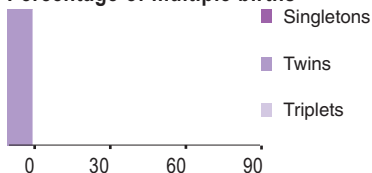

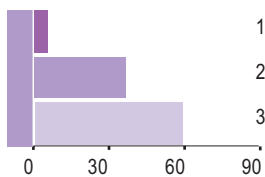

Percentage of ICSI (0%) vs IVF (100%) for the Centre

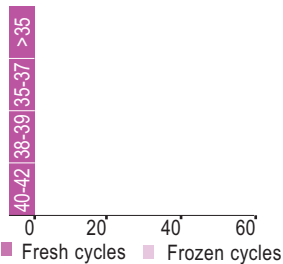
Percentage of multiple births

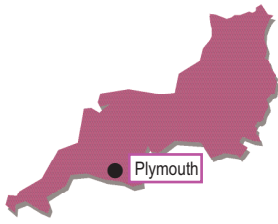

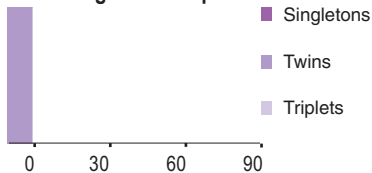

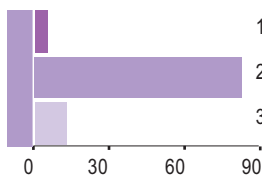

Percentage of ICSI (57%) vs IVF (43%) for the Centre

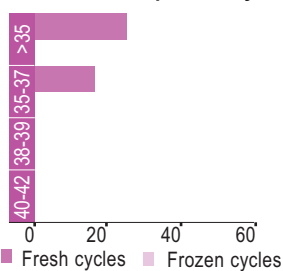
Percentage of multiple births

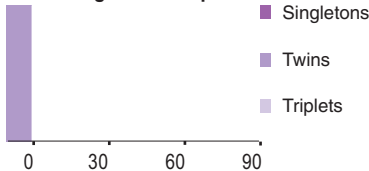

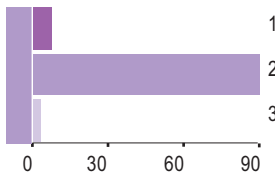

Percentage of ICSI (32%) vs IVF (68%) for the Centre

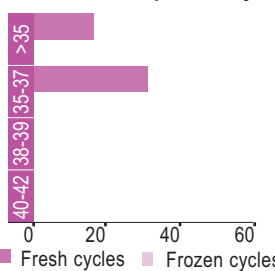
Percentage of multiple births
