**DATA PRESENTATION IN FUTURE PATIENTS GUIDE**

**Introduction**

1. Following a meeting of the Clinic Information Working Group, it was agreed that the information in the HFEA's Patient Guide needs to be statistically significant and biologically relevant. Furthermore it needs to be relatively easy to access and has to in a format which is understood by patients.

**Issues for Discussion**

2. This group suggested four methods:

<b>Suggested method</b>	<b>Patient help</b>	<b>Ease of access</b>	<b>Statistically significant</b>	<b>Biologically/clinically relevant</b>
Elective single embryo transfer				
3 yr rolling 2 embryo under 38				
Live birth event/fresh embryo transferred, over 3 yr period, in under 38, in first cycle of treatment (no donated eggs)				
As above, but for first three cycles averaged in under 40s i.e. NICE NHS criteria				

3. Members are asked to discuss the applicability of the four proposed methods.

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
