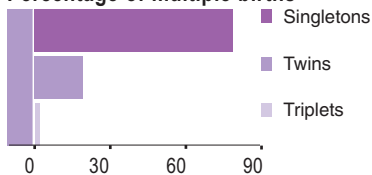
Clinic type

NHS clinic but will also allow patients who are ineligible for NHS funding, or who require further unfunded cycles to pay for their treatment.

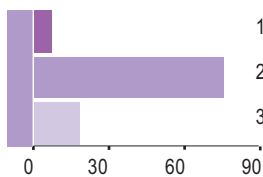

Percentage of ICSI (32%) vs IVF (68%) for the Centre

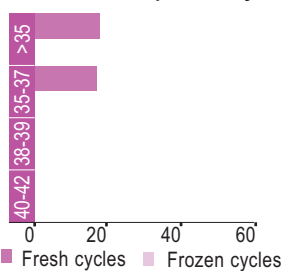
Percentage of multiple births

Services offered now

IVF Activities

IVF, ICSI, treatment with donor gametes or donor embryos, partial surrogacy, full surrogacy. Treatment limit: For self funding patients the number of treatment cycles offered will be dependent upon each individual case. For NHS patients there is one treatment cycle of IVF/ICSI offered if patients fulfill the criteria implemented by Health Commissioning Wales.

DI/GIFT/IUI Activities

DI, IUI with partner sperm. Treatment limit: For NHS patients dependant upon contracts purchased by various Local Health Boards. Self funded clients treatment offered on individual basis.

Other information

PESA, TESA, sperm assessment, cycle monitoring, ovulation induction, tubal surgery, other reproductive surgery, tubal Assessment Laparoscopy and dye Hysteroconstrastsography (HyCoSy). Eligibility criteria relate to female age, relationship status, number of previous children, single women, same sex couples, patients from abroad.

Donor recruitment

Sperm donors recruited. Egg donors recruited. Centre accepts known donors, known donors used for known recipient.

Support services

Independent counselling on/off-site. As many counselling sessions as required are included in cost of treatment. Dedicated counsellor, team approach, female doctor available.

Storage activities

Sperm storage, embryo storage. Sperm stored from donors. Embryos stored from donors and patients.

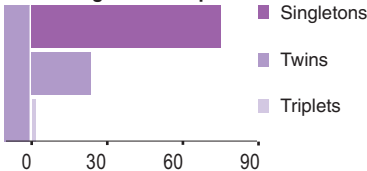
Clinic type

Private clinic but will also offer treatment to patients funded by the NHS where a suitable contract exists.

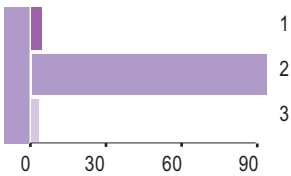

Percentage of ICSI (50%) vs IVF (50%) for the Centre

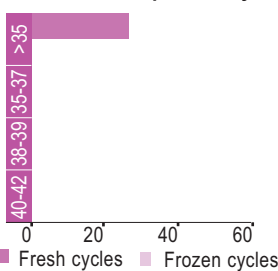
Percentage of multiple births

IVF Activities

IVF, ICSI, treatment with donor gametes or donor embryos, assisted hatching. There is no limit to the number of cycles a patient can undergo.

DI/GIFT/IUI Activities

DI, IUI with partner sperm, natural cycle IUI/DI. There is no limit to the number of cycles a patient can undergo.

Other information

PESA, sperm assessment, cycle monitoring, ovulation induction, HyCoSy

Donor recruitment

Sperm donors recruited. Egg sharing. Centre accepts known donors, known donors used for known recipient.

Support services

Independent counselling on/off-site. One counselling session is included in the cost of treatment - further counselling costs £45 per session. Centre holds open days. One physician throughout treatment, dedicated counsellor, team approach.

Storage activities

Egg storage, sperm storage, embryo storage. Sperm stored from donors, from patients, for oncology patients. Embryos stored from donors and patients.
