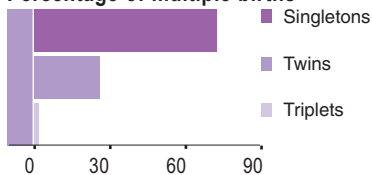

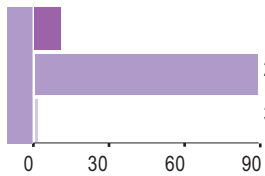

Percentage of ICSI (38%) vs IVF (62%) for the Centre

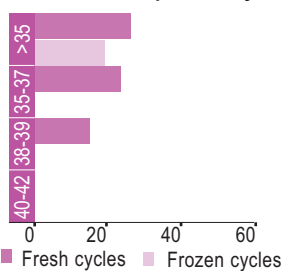
Percentage of multiple births

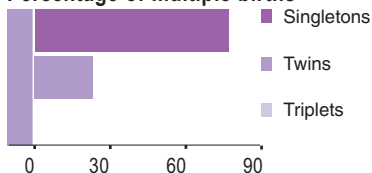

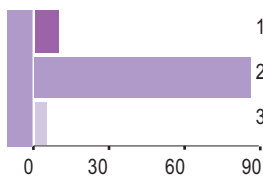

Percentage of ICSI (37%) vs IVF (63%) for the Centre

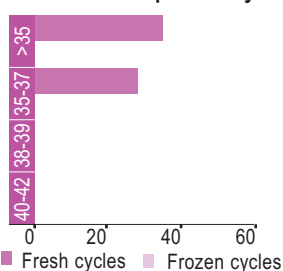
Percentage of multiple births

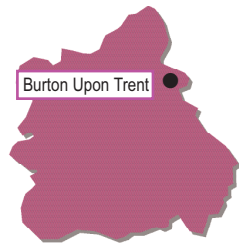

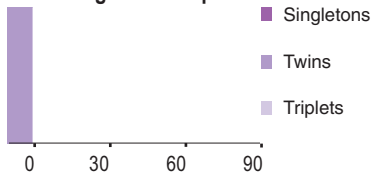

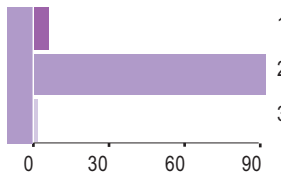

Percentage of ICSI (37%) vs IVF (63%) for the Centre

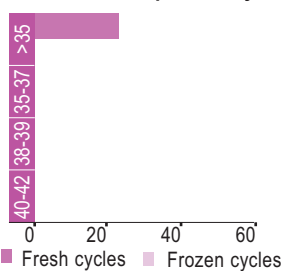
Percentage of multiple births

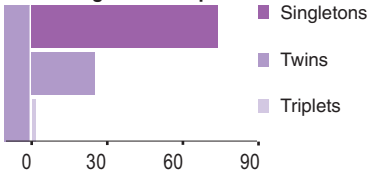

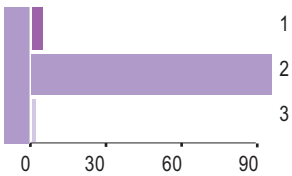

Percentage of ICSI (66%) vs IVF (34%) for the Centre

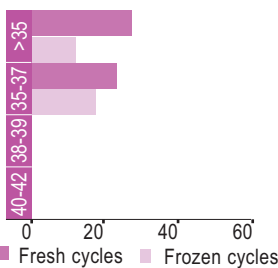
Percentage of multiple births

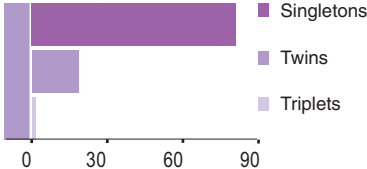

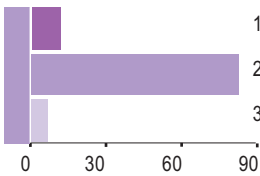

Percentage of ICSI (67%) vs IVF (33%) for the Centre

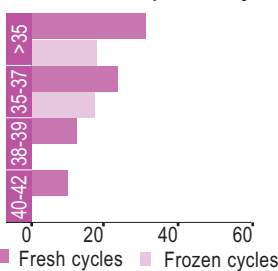
Percentage of multiple births

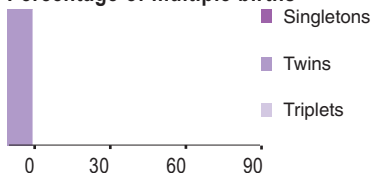

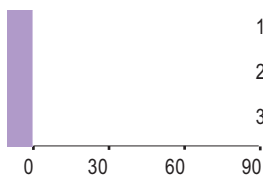

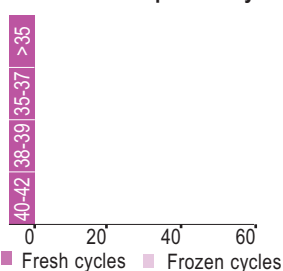
Percentage of multiple births

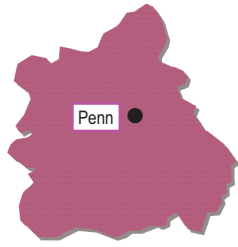

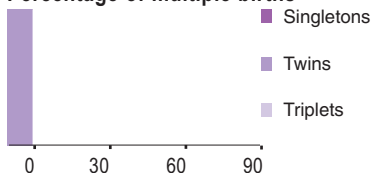

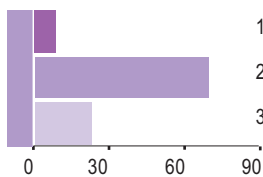

Percentage of ICSI (41%) vs IVF (59%) for the Centre

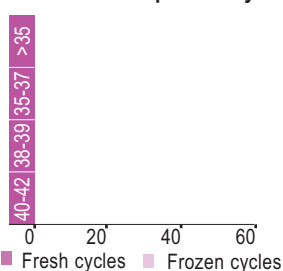
Percentage of multiple births

DI, IUI with partner sperm, natural cycle IUI/DI, treatment facilities for patients with communicable viral infections. Treatment limit: Variable, depending on clinical history, age and course of previous cycles.

Other information

MESA, PESA, TESA, sperm assessment, cycle monitoring, ovulation induction, tubal surgery, other reproductive surgery, other

Reproductive Surgery: Reversal of sterilization, Ovarian Diathermy, Myomectomy. Treatment information in other languages: Interpreter service. Eligibility criteria relate to female age, single women, same sex couples.

Donor recruitment

Egg donors recruited. Egg sharing. Centre accepts known donors, known donors used for known recipient, known donors entered into donor pool.

Support services

Independent counselling on-site. Up to 3 counselling sessions are included in the cost of treatment - further counselling costs £60 per session. Centre holds open

days. Independent support group available: Being set up. One physician throughout treatment, named nurse system, dedicated counsellor.

Storage activities

Egg storage, sperm storage, embryo storage, storage of materials from patients with communicable viral infections. Sperm stored from patients and for oncology patients. Embryos stored from donors and patients.
