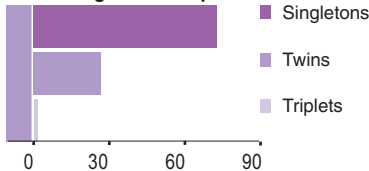

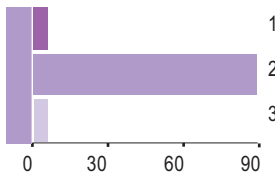

Percentage of ICSI (44%) vs IVF (56%) for the Centre

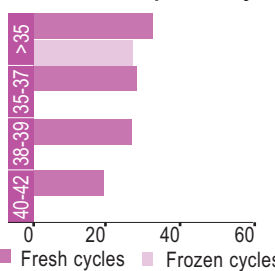
Percentage of multiple births

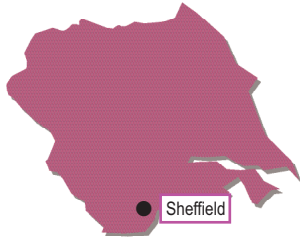

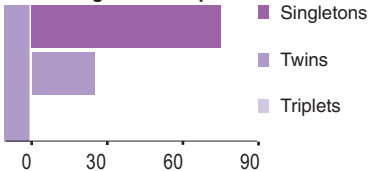

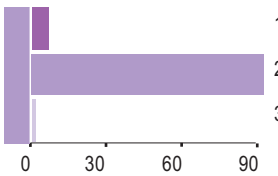

IVF (54%) for the Centre

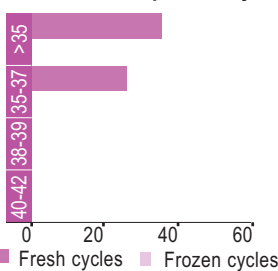
Percentage of multiple births

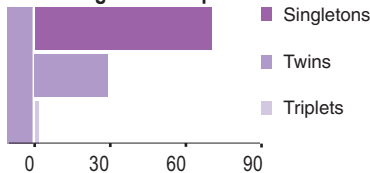

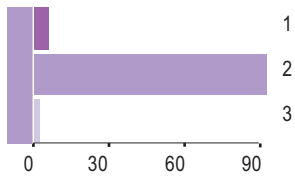

Percentage of ICSI (33%) vs IVF (67%) for the Centre

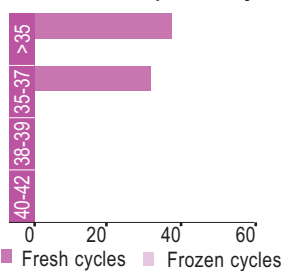
Percentage of multiple births

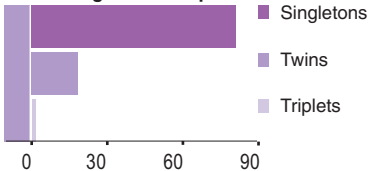

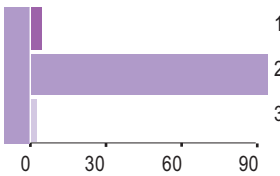

Percentage of ICSI (47%) vs IVF (53%) for the Centre

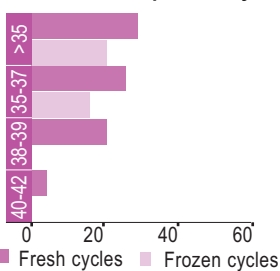
Percentage of multiple births

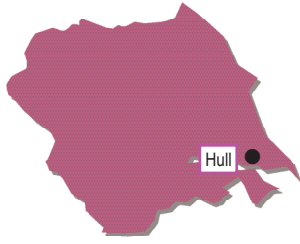

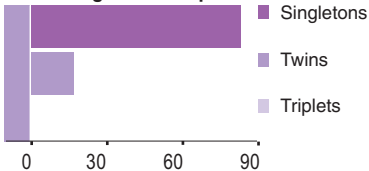

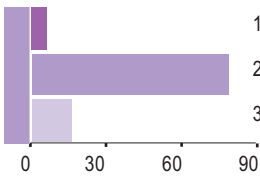

Percentage of ICSI (38%) vs IVF (62%) for the Centre

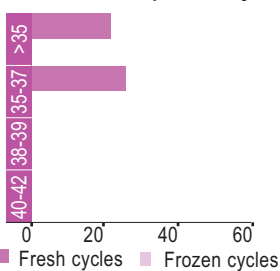
Percentage of multiple births
