

How to read the clinic pages

Treatments offered

◆ IVF

Eggs removed from the ovaries are fertilised with sperm in a laboratory dish before being placed in the woman's body.

◆ ICSI

Involves injecting a single sperm directly into the centre of cytoplasm of an egg which is then placed in the woman's body using conventional IVF methods

◆ DI

The introduction of donor sperm into the vagina, the cervix or womb itself. Using a fine tube, the doctor or nurse places the sperm into the neck of the womb or the uterus.

◆ IUI

The insemination of sperm into the uterus of a woman following ovarian stimulation

◆ GIFT

Eggs retrieved from a woman, mixed with sperm immediately replaced in one or other of the woman's fallopian tubes so that they fertilise inside the body (in vitro).

◆ PGS

One or two cells from an embryo are removed to be tested to ensure they contain the correct number of chromosomes (known as aneuploidy).

◆ PGD

One or two cells from an embryo are removed to be tested for specific genetic disorders/characteristics before embryo transfer takes place.

Clinic type

- NHS clinic, offers treatment to NHS funded patients only

- NHS clinic, but will also allow patients who are ineligible for NHS funding or who require further unfunded cycles to pay for their treatment.

- Private clinic, offers treatment to fee paying patients only

Private clinic, but will also offer treatment to patients funded by the NHS where a suitable contract exists

NHS clinic but will also allow patients who are ineligible for NHS funding, or who require further unfunded cycles to pay for their treatment.

Patients over the age of 42 were treated by this clinic during the reporting period.

Treatments offered

IVF, IUI, ICSI, DI, GIFT, PGD

Services offered

IVF activities

IVF, ZIFT, ICSI, treatment with donor gametes or donor embryos, full surrogacy.

DI/GIFT/IUI activities

DI, GIFT, IUI w/partner sperm, natural cycle IUI/DI. Treatment limit: A maximum of 6 usually recommended.

Other information

PESA, TESA, PGD, Sperm assessment, cycle monitoring, post-coital checks, ovulation induction, tubal surgery, other reproductive surgery. Eligibility criteria relate to female age, BMI. No facilities available for patients with viral communicable infections.

Satellite centres

Transport IVF offered.

Donor recruitment

Sperm donors recruited. Egg donors recruited. Egg sharing. Centre accepts known donors, known donors used for known recipient, known donors entered into donor pool.

Support services

Independent counselling off-site. As many counselling sessions required are included in cost of treatment. Dedicated counselor, team approach.

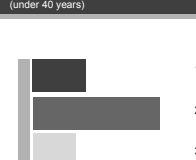
Storage activities

Sperm storage, embryo storage. Sperm stored from donors, from patients, for oncology patients. Embryos stored from donors and patients.

Services offered

IVF Activities

- ◆ Listed in this section are the IVF treatments and activities carried out at the clinic

- ◆ Limits to the number of treatment cycles per patient, where this information has been provided.

DI/GIFT/IUI Activities

- ◆ Listed in this section are the DI/GIFT, IUI and related treatments carried out at the clinic.

- ◆ Limits to the number of treatment cycles, where this information has been provided.

Other information

- ◆ A list of any other treatments and services provided by the clinic.
- ◆ Details of any eligibility criteria.

Treatment information in other languages

- ◆ Shows where the clinic can provide information in other languages.

Donor recruitment

- ◆ Information available on the recruitment of sperm donors, egg donors, and the availability of egg sharing. It also indicates if the clinic accepts donors known to patients.

Support services

- ◆ Information on support available.

Storage facilities.

- ◆ Shows if the clinic stores eggs, eggs within ovarian tissue, sperm, sperm within testicular tissue and embryos. It also indicates if the centres store these for patients undergoing treatment assisted conception treatment, donors or oncology patients and patients with viral infections.

Satellite and transport centres

- ◆ Information on clinics which provide early stages of infertility treatment with the latter stage of treatment being carried out at a main hospital or clinic.
