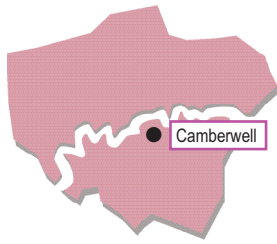

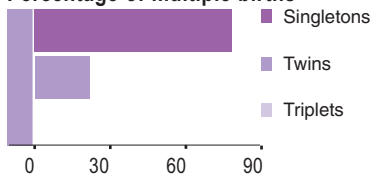

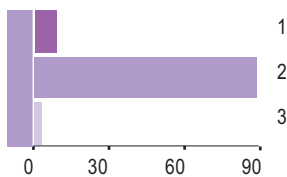

Percentage of ICSI (54%) vs IVF (46%) for the Centre

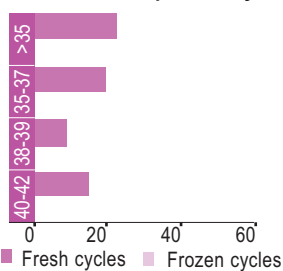
Percentage of multiple births

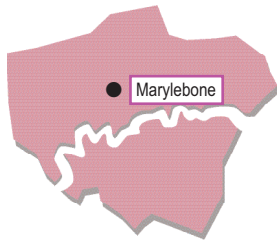

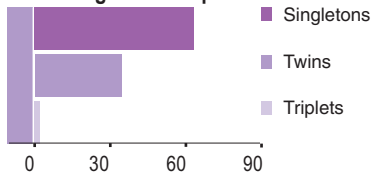

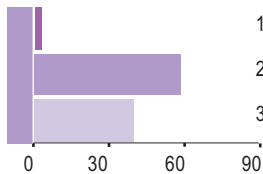

Percentage of ICSI (76%) vs IVF (24%) for the Centre

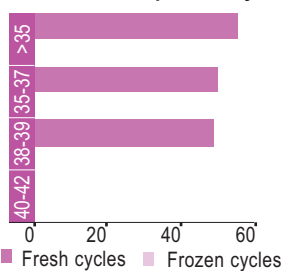
Percentage of multiple births

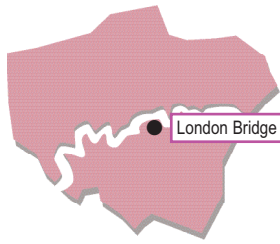

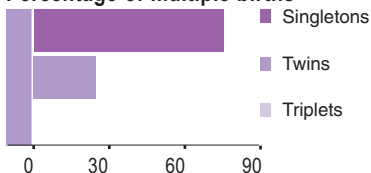

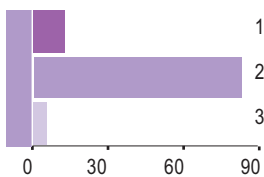

Percentage of ICSI (41%) vs IVF (59%) for the Centre

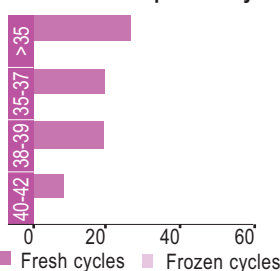
Percentage of multiple births

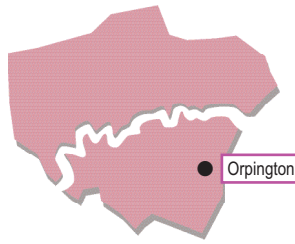

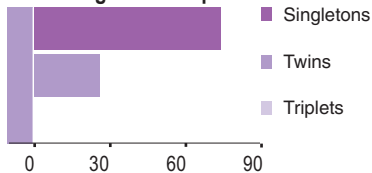

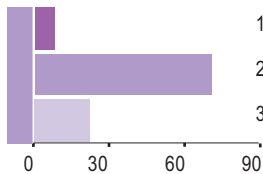

Percentage of ICSI (53%) vs IVF (47%) for the Centre

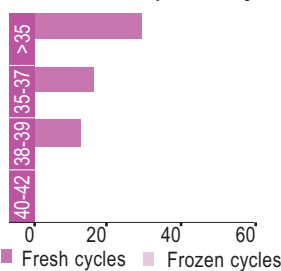
Percentage of multiple births

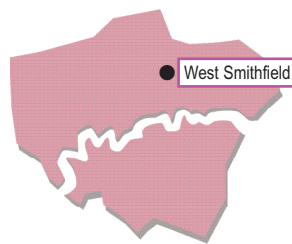

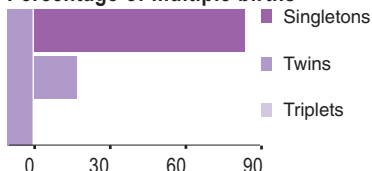

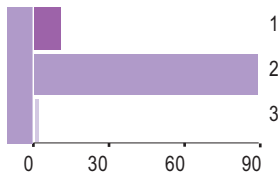

Percentage of ICSI (38%) vs IVF (62%) for the Centre

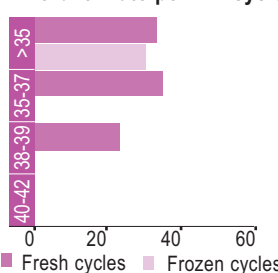
Percentage of multiple births

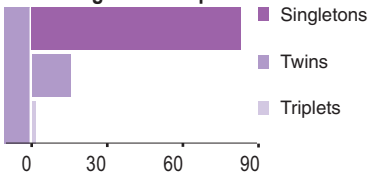

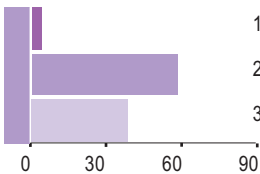

Percentage of ICSI (40%) vs IVF (60%) for the Centre

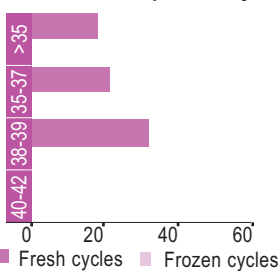
Percentage of multiple births

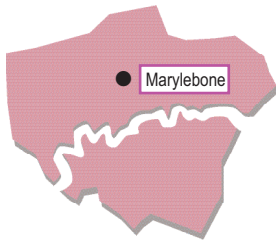

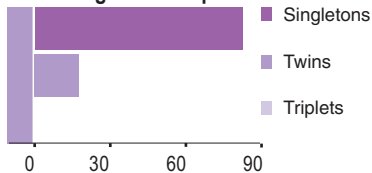

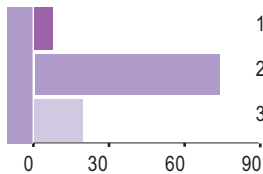

Percentage of ICSI (41%) vs IVF (59%) for the Centre

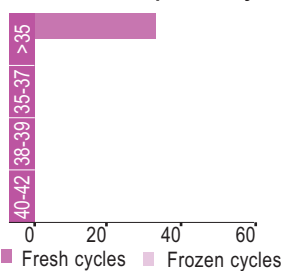
Percentage of multiple births

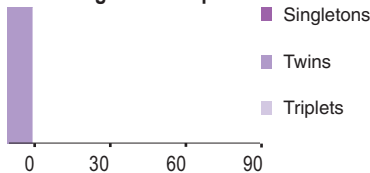

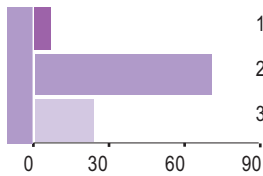

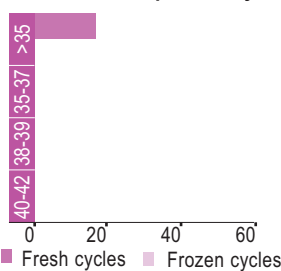
Percentage of multiple births

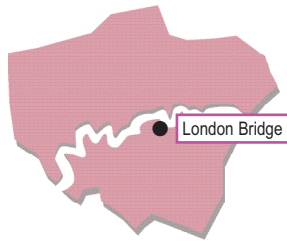

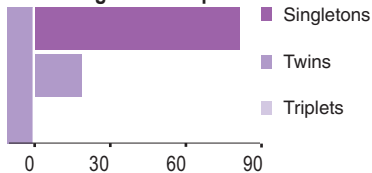

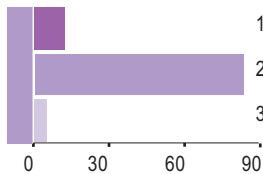

Percentage of ICSI (48%) vs IVF (52%) for the Centre

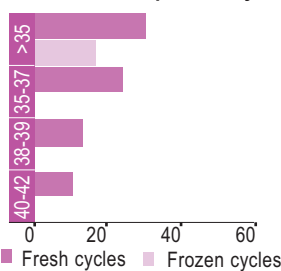
Percentage of multiple births

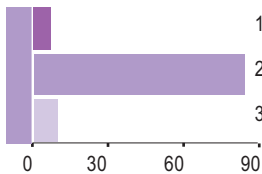

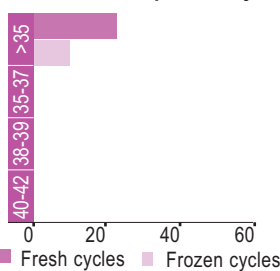
Percentage of multiple births

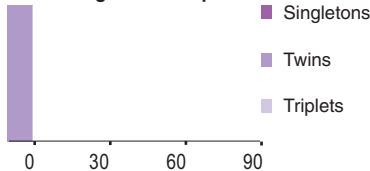

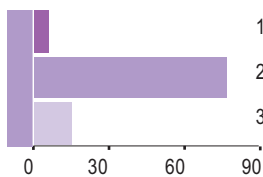

Percentage of ICSI (60%) vs IVF (40%) for the Centre

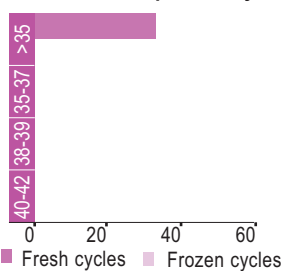
Percentage of multiple births

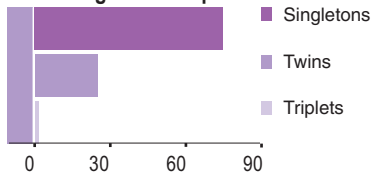

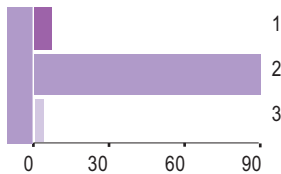

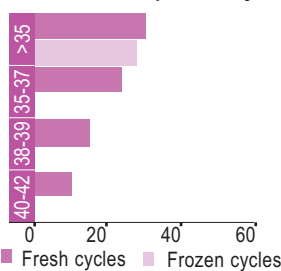
Percentage of multiple births

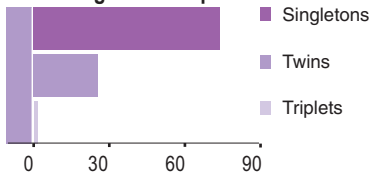

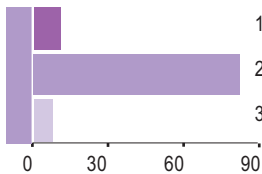

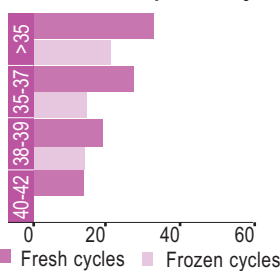
Percentage of multiple births

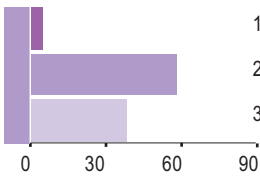

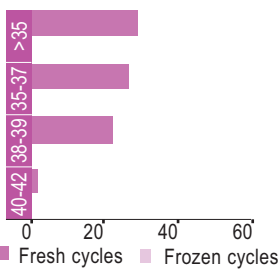
Percentage of multiple births

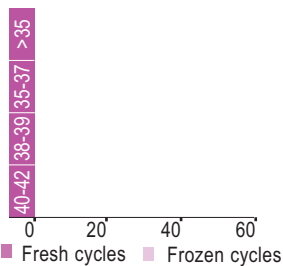

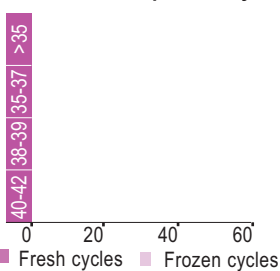
Percentage of multiple births

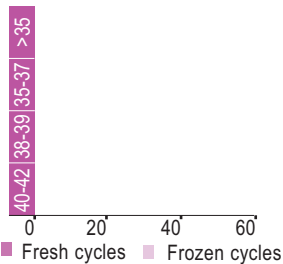
Percentage of multiple births

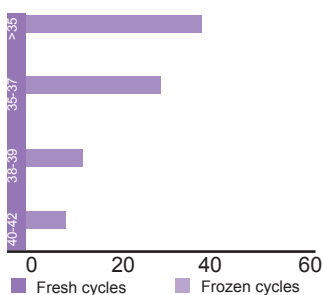
Percentage of multiple births

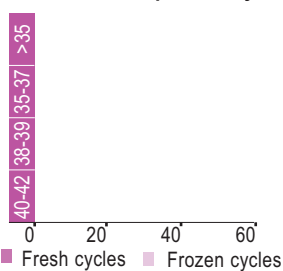
Percentage of multiple births

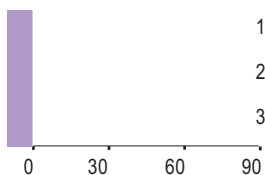

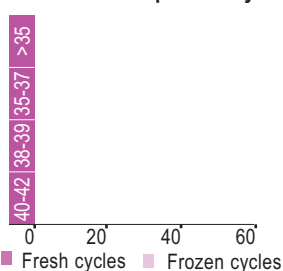
Percentage of multiple births

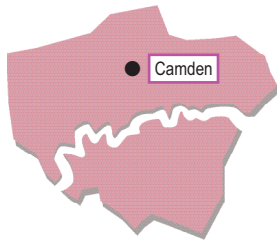

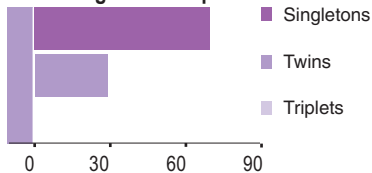

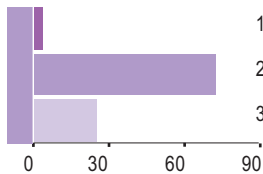

Percentage of ICSI (51%) vs IVF (49%) for the Centre

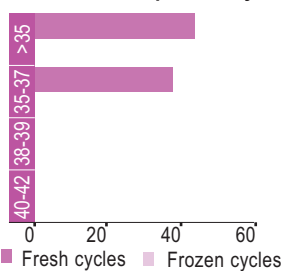
Percentage of multiple births
