Please note that the term IVF covers both explicit IVF and ICSI, where donor sperm was used. Nontreatment cycles such as egg collections are also included. The sum of "Patients whose first ever treatment is DI, by first year of Treatment" and "Patients whose first ever treatment is IVF, by first year of treatment" is slightly greater than "Patients undergoing their first ever treatment" because of patients who started an IVF cycle that was subsequently abandoned, or who underwent a DI cycle after starting an IVF cycle.
