Summary of request

The Authority was asked for the number of surplus embryos currently frozen in the UK.

HFEA response

The information since 1991 can be found in the table below. Please note that this is a count of all embryos being stored. Embryos may subsequently be removed from storage for use, because they have reached the end of their permitted storage period, the patient no longer requires them, the donor has withdrawn consent or for research purposes.

When the numbers are between one and four they have been replaced with a '<5' figure. This is because there is a significant possibility that this information, when combined with other information to which you may reasonably be expected to have access, could lead to the identification of a person to whom the HFEA owes a duty of confidentiality. To disclose this information in these circumstances may therefore result in a breach of the confidentiality provisions of section 33A of the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Act 1990 (as amended). The information is therefore exempt from disclosure under section 44 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
